This year will see our competitive league split into two nights (instead of late games). Team will play either Wednesday or Thursday night at 7:30pm

Silver Broom Mixed League.....Our active seniors (55+ years) section offers daytime curling in a relaxed, social atmosphere for both ladies & gents. Teams are drawn up from those present on a daily basis allowing you to curl as much or as little as you want.
